The term originates from ancient Greek (ὁλιγαρχία - oligarkhía). Aristotle used the term to mean an unfavorable version of an aristocratic government.

Oligarchies can exist within a range of political systems, including aristocracies, dictatorships, absolute monarchies, and communist regimes.
